

What to Expect?

At our rustic resort on the North Coast you will experience a jam packed adventure with some if not all of the following activities Abseiling, Archery, Kayaking, Water challenges and lots of exciting Survivor tasks n Challenges... Our venue creates a fantastic backdrop to suite the survivor theme and we provide team bandanas, tribal flags, background music and other props to create the perfect atmosphere.

What's included?

We will start the day off with some fun Ice breakers and playful games and then separate the tribes before setting them off on their challenges followed by a delicious lunch before you round off the day with another two hour rotation and then Tribal council in the boma area. We will also supply teams with matching bandana's with the Survivor Logo and should you wish to order t-shirts company logos printed on them please arrange with Nicci for a costing.

Who can take part?

If you are a corporate, a sports team, a church group or simply a group of friends and you're looking for something to take part in as part of a Yearend treat then this is for you. KZN has plenty of companies with staff of less than 10people so why not enter one or two teams or even form Tribal Mergers with clients or suppliers as a form of year end celebrations. Each Tribe must consist of at least 4 members and a maximum of 6. There will be a bonus points system for teams with women.

How much will it cost?

Entry is R2000 for a package rate per team or R350pp and this will include the full day of activities, facilitation and equipment together with matching tribal bandana's, lunch, a race pack and two soft drinks each.

Where is it?

Its at our venue on the North Coast called Seula Zimbili, near Zinkwazi/Darnell. The venue is 90km North of Durban. **(Directions to follow)** N2 It's far from Luxurious but rather focused on Adventure but should you require accommodation to turn the days adventure into an evening around the fire it's an additional R295pp which will include dinner, accommodation and breakfast. Alternatively you can move your group across to Zinkwazi Lagoon Lodge to enjoy an evening along the river's edge.(Please enquire with Linda about rates)

What do we need?

Most importantly besides a good sense of adventure you'll need Casual Clothing and Comfortable Shoes (actually read Closed shoes/tackies). Swimming costume or towel (just in case). Sun block & Camera (If you choose) And some Fresh Water. Team colours and Shirts will also add to the excitement so please feel free to contact me should you need a quote on clothing and any other extra's.

How do we Enter?

Every person will be required to sign an indemnity form (just in case) but medical supplies and first aiders will be available for basic injuries.
